Cougar Crest Viognier is picked ripe and luscious, fermented to dryness in the true French tradition. Whole cluster pressed and cold fermented in at 54 degrees for approximately 3 months. Floral, citrus, and ripe melon aromas tempt the nose, as pear and white peach flavors please the palate. A smooth honey-like finish with balanced acidity makes this an ideal match for rich white sauces, chicken, and grilled pork tenderloin.



2010 GRENACHE ROSÉ

Grenache Rose is summertime in a bottle with upfront flavors of fresh strawberry and rhubarb combined with a hint of spice for a crisp finish. A wine that pairs well with salads, seafood, salmon, ribs, or even pizza. Delicious all by itself on a warm summer evening or paired with spicy appetizers.

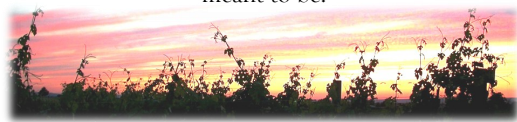
